After takeoff we continue north east into the Caprivi Strip, into a very water-rich area. Arrive in time for lunch. In the afternoon you can do the selfguided walking trail all along the edge of the lagoon, or just relax at the pool the next day you will go on a morning boat cruise on the Kwando River, before you return to the lodge in time for lunch. In the afternoon you will be transferred by boat to the BwaBwata National Park, where you will embark on a game drive in open 4x4 vehicles. You have excellent chance to spot Elephant and Buffalo in this area. Return to the lodge in time for Dinner.
