The Kenai is not behind safety glass, or a deck rail. Your face feels the cold wind on the train and your heart pounds with the strike of a monster fish. Your adrenaline rushes at the sight of a bear, and your skin chills as you step on a glacier. Nothing about the Kenai Peninsula is formal or stuffy. In fact, no other destination offers such an up close and personal Alaskan experience. With over 15,000 square miles of extraordinary adventure and excitement to choose from, even the rest of the state comes here when they need a reminder of why they moved to Alaska in the first place. That's why we are known as Alaska's Playground.

KENAI RIVER SILVER SALMON FISHING

No trip to Alaska is complete without wetting a line! Spend the day on the world famous Kenai River with a professional fishing guide targeting the "residents choice" sportfish, Silver Salmon.

This Day of Adventure you will depart from the Dena'ina center and head to Anchorage International Airport where you will take a short 20 minute commuter flight to the City of Kenai located on the Kenai Peninsula.

From the Kenai airport you will be met by your guide and head to the Kenai River, known for it's mind blowing glacially fed brilliant blue waters. The Kenai is the most popular sportfishing river in Alaska, anglers from all over the world fish it each season.

You will spend the day in a power boat on the river targeting Silvers, averaging 10-13 lbs. and known for their fighting spirit and acrobatics at the end of a line.

While you are fishing you will be treated to the beautiful scenery of the Central Peninsula, and it isn't unusual

to see Bald Eagles, Moose and Caribou.

Should you decide to keep your catch rather than catch and release, your fish will be processed, frozen and shipped home for you (if the laws of your home country allow for the import of salmon.)

You will be required to purchase a one day fishing license, cost will be covered by the Kenai Peninsula Tourism Marketing Council.

Lunch will be provided on the boat.

What to bring: Warm layered clothing, rain gear, a camera, snacks.
