

ATWS 2016 - ADVENTURE DAY ITINERARY

Just south of Anchorage along the Turnagain Arm is one of the most scenic places in all of Southcentral Alaska, Portage Valley. Surrounded by hanging glaciers, with blue rivers and bountiful wildlife, Portage Valley is a must-see for anyone visiting the area.

The tour begins with a scenic drive along the Turnagain Arm, followed by an easy one hour hike to beautiful Byron Glacier. Following the hike, you will visit the Begich Boggs Visitor Center for lunch and to learn more about Alaska's glaciers and what makes this area so unique.

A stop at the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center will get you up-close with some of Alaska's most iconic mammals in a their natural setting. Moose, bear, musk ox, wood bison, caribou and more!

Tour includes transportation, lunch, snacks and a professional guide. Trip departs Dena'ina Convention Center at 8:30 a.m. with an approximate return time of 5:30 p.m.
